

**GRANT COUNTY  
RESOLUTION NO. 14-31**

**VOLUNTARY RECOGNITION OF A PETITIONING BARGAINING UNIT THAT  
INCLUDES THE NON-PROBATIONARY BUS DRIVERS EMPLOYED BY GRANT  
COUNTY, NEW MEXICO UNDER CORRE CAMINOS**

**WHEREAS**, A Petition seeking certification to be the exclusive bargaining representative for purposes of collective bargaining was filed with the Public Employee Labor Relations Board by the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, New Mexico Council 18; and

**WHEREAS**, the group seeking to become a bargaining unit under the Petition includes the non-probationary bus drivers employed by Grant County at Corre Caminos; and

**WHEREAS**, the employer, Grant County must determine whether it will voluntarily recognize the new bargaining unit or whether it will require an election by the potential members of the bargaining unit.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Grant County Board of Commissioners hereby voluntarily recognize the non-probationary bus drivers of Corre Caminos, pursuant to PELRB, Case No. 305-14, as a bargaining unit with the exclusive representation of American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, New Mexico, Council 18.
