

RESOLUTION R-15-04

APPROVING AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND

WHEREAS, North Hurley was designated a Colonias August 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, North Hurley Road is in need of repair because of hazardous conditions to the drainages and roadway; and

WHEREAS, Grant County will utilize the plan and design completed from a previous allocation of the Colonias Infrastructure Fund; and

WHEREAS, North Hurley Road is less than 150 miles from the U.S.-Mexican Border; and

WHEREAS, the County assures and certifies that it will comply with all regulations, policies, guidelines and requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of the Colonias Infrastructure Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the Governing Body in and for Grant County that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GRANT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
