

RESOLUTION R-15-05
APPROVING AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE
AUTHORITY UNDER THE COLONIAS INFRASTRUCTURE FUND

WHEREAS, the unincorporated community of Tyrone was designated a Colonias March 18, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalks and drainages in Tyrone are in need of improvements in order to meet ADA regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, Grant County will utilize standard ADA compliance plan and design for the construction; and

WHEREAS, Tyrone is less than 150 miles from the U.S.-Mexican Border; and

WHEREAS, the County assures and certifies that it will comply with all regulations, policies, guidelines and requirements with respect to the acceptance and use of the Colonias Infrastructure Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the majority opinion of the Governing Body in and for Grant County that the proposed grant will be in the best interest of the residents of the community.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GRANT COUNTY BOARD OF
