

RESOLUTION NO. 15-10

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER AN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Article X, § 7 of the New Mexico State Constitution provides that a “board of county commissioners by unanimous vote may adopt an ordinance to increase the size of the board[] of county commissioners to five members”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Grant County Commissioners desires to consider such an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, in order to consider such an ordinance, the Commission must publish notice of its intention to do so at least 14 days before the meeting at which the ordinance will be considered, in accordance with NMSA (1978) § 4-37-7.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GRANT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:

1. That an ordinance, entitled AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE SIZE OF THE BOARD OF GRANT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO FIVE MEMBERS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE X, SECTION 7 OF THE NEW MEXICO CONSTITUTION, to be introduced before the Board shall be filed with the County Clerk, and shall be considered by the Board at a regular meeting held on April 23, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. in Commissioners’ Chambers of the Grant County Administration Building, 1400 Highway 180 East, Silver City, New Mexico, in the County, being the regular meeting place of the Board.

2. That the following notice of intent shall be published one time in the Silver City Daily Press, a newspaper of general circulation in the County, following the adoption of this resolution:

WHEREAS, Article X, § 7 of the New Mexico State Constitution provides that a “board of county commissioners by unanimous vote may adopt an ordinance to increase the size of the board[] of county commissioners to five members”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Grant County Commissioners (“Board”) finds that it is in the best interest of Grant County and its citizens to increase the Board to five members; and

WHEREAS, the Board duly published notice of its intention to consider the present ordinance at least 14 days prior to the present meeting, in accordance with NMSA (1978) § 4-37-7; and

WHEREAS, the Board held an open public hearing on the consideration of the present ordinance at which there was an opportunity for public comment.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF GRANT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO THAT:**

1. For all elections to the office of County Commissioner of the County of Grant, New Mexico commencing in 2016 and continuing thereafter, the Board of Grant County Commissioners shall be composed of five members, pursuant to Article X, § 7 of the New Mexico State Constitution; and
2. Upon creation of a five-member board, the county shall be divided by the incumbent board of county commissioners into five county commission districts that shall be compact, contiguous and as nearly equal in population as practicable; and
3. One county commissioner shall reside within and be elected from each county commission district.
