RESOLUTION NO. R-15-30**

DECLARATION OF DISASTER IN GRANT COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Hanover Mutual Domestic Water Consumer Association produces water from a water system for the citizens of Hanover located in Grant County, New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2015, the Hanover Mutual Domestic Water Consumer Association's water system suffered a major break in a water main line; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the break approximately 45 of 100 customers are without water; and

WHEREAS, due to the severity of the break repairs could take up to three days; and


WHEREAS, the Hanover Mutual Domestic Water Consumer Association must address the emergency repairs to their water system and lack of water availability in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and


WHEREAS, the magnitude of this emergency is beyond the resource capabilities of the Hanover Mutual Domestic Water Consumer Association; and

WHEREAS, Grant County's annual budget does not provide for expenses and services required to respond to the lack of water from the Hanover Water Association's water system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Grant County Board of Commissioners and that they hereby do declare a disaster in the community of Hanover, New Mexico located in Grant County due to a water system failure, and hereby request all available assistance from State and Federal resources in addressing loss and damages incurred, until the disaster is completely mitigated.
