RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT ROADS WITHIN THE BRANDING IRON SUBDIVISION FOR MAINTENANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have accepted the first phase of roads within the Branding Iron Subdivision for maintenance during a Regular Meeting on April 19, 2018 and;


WHEREAS, the roads to be accepted for maintenance are described from bar ditch to bar ditch as Branding Iron Trail (0.41) miles from the intersection of Cottage San Road west to end of cul-de-sac, Charolais Drive (0.05) miles from intersection of Branding Iron Trail north to end of cul-de-sac, Hereford Drive (0.07) miles from intersection of Branding Iron Trail west to end of cul-de-sac, and Angus Drive (0.1) miles from intersection of Branding Iron Trail west to end of cul-de-sac. This will not include any walk path's or storm retention ponds and;


WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners requests to add said roadways to the 2018 Certified County Maintained Road Inventory.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Grant County Commissioners that Branding Iron Trail, Charolais Drive, Hereford Drive and Angus Drive be accepted for maintenance.


