
WHEREAS, the Burro Mountains are a popular Gila National Forest access point for hunting, fishing, mining and recreation and;

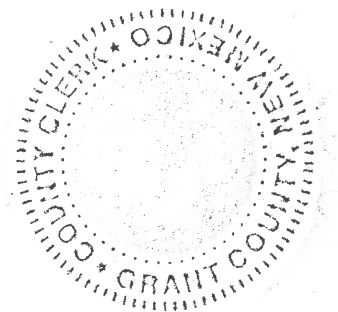


