A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CASAS ADOBES SUBDIVISION AS A COLONIA

WHEREAS, The Grant County Commission wishes to designate Casas Adobes subdivision as a "Colonia" as defined by the Housing and Urban Development Cranston Gonzales Act and the United States Rural Development, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision is an unincorporated area in Grant County, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision was in existence prior to October 1, 1989 by USDA definition and November 28, 1990 as defined by the state, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision came into existence in February 24, 1982, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision is within 150 miles of the border, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision does not have a wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision has an inadequate water system, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision has inadequate housing, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes subdivision meets the definition of a colonia as established by HUD and USDA, and

WHEREAS, Casas Adobes has a population of less than 10,000, and


WHEREAS, Grant County has attached the documentation meeting the criteria listed above; and






