RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF GRANT COUNTY PARCEL NO. R073935 (1.321 (+/-) ACRES OF LAND, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "OLD ALDO SCHOOL") FROM URIC-GSA

WHEREAS, the Grant County Board of Commissioners ("County") desires to acquire a parcel of property and building currently owned by URIC-GSA, a New Mexico Limited liability Company (URIC); and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to use the property for the purpose of a Public Safety Complex to house the Grant County Sheriff's Office, Grant County Emergency Management Department and Emergency Operations Center and Grant County Regional Dispatch Authority; and

WHEREAS, URIC desires to sell the property to the County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GRANT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:

The Grant County Manager is authorized to proceed with the purchase of real property for the purposes of a Public Safety Complex under terms contained within the attached real estate purchase agreement.
