**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING  
AN AUDIT OF THE CANCER CENTER CONTRACT PROCESS**

**WHEREAS**, Board of Trustees of Gila Regional Medical Center recently finalized a contract with UNM Comprehensive Cancer Center (UNM); and

**WHEREAS**, this was a change from the New Mexico Cancer Center (NMCC), the provider that served GRMC cancer patients for many years; and


**WHEREAS**, patients and their families have expressed concerns about the process that brought forth the change; and


**WHEREAS**, the Cancer Center is not fully operational at this time forcing cancer patients to travel to obtain treatment and care; and


