WHEREAS, FMI has declared the Final Plat to be vacated and requests that the Grant County Board of Commissioners ("Commission") approve the vacation of the Final Plat as required under NMSA (1978) 47-6-7; and


WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that the vacation of the Final Plat will not adversely affect the interests of persons on contiguous land or persons within the subdivision being vacated.

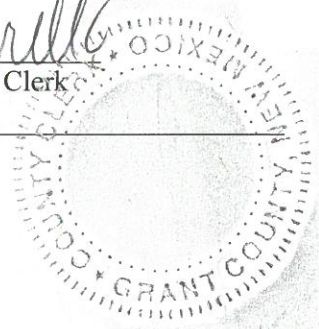
