

In response to Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham's directive instructing New Mexico residents to stay home in order to minimize public health risk in the wake of the COVID-19 public health emergency, SWSWA will implement the following changes to operating hours:

Main landfill Silver City:

Monday – Friday 8:00 am to 3:30 pm for large loads (main dumping area).

Monday – Friday 8:00am-4:00 pm small loads (convenience station area)

Saturday 8:00 am- 12:00 pm All loads

Tri-City Transfer Station:

Tuesday – Friday 9:00 am – 4:00 pm

Saturday 8:00 am – 12:00 pm

Cliff/Gila Station:

Tuesdays and Thursdays 9:00am-4:00pm

Saturdays 8:00 am – 12:00pm

Mimbres Station:

Tuesdays and Thursday 9:00 am – 4:00 pm

Saturdays 8:00 am – 12:00 pm

These hours will begin on Thursday March 26, 2020 and remain in effect until April 10, 2020 at which time the hours will be revisited and revised as necessary.

In response to Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham's directive instructing New Mexico residents to stay home in order to minimize public health risk in the wake of the COVID-19 public health emergency, SWSWA has recommended the following guidelines for customers utilizing the facilities:

- SWSWA requests that customers who are who have been sick/experiencing flu like symptoms do not use landfill and transfer station facilities, please send another individual to dispose of your trash.
- Customers should limit themselves to ONE load per day.
- SWSWA requests that customers limit the number of people coming together to the landfill. Preferably One person only.
- If more than one person must come to the landfill (especially children and high-risk individuals) please have them remain in the vehicle at all times.
- Please ensure that loads brought to the landfill are "bagged" and ready to dispose of promptly.
- Please limit the time spent disposing of your trash to the least amount of time possible.
- Please refrain from visiting with other customers and employees when disposing of trash.
- Customers should protect themselves when using the landfill or transfer stations by maintaining the recommended 6-foot social distance to reduce coronavirus transmission risks.
- SWSWA requests your cooperation in refraining from bringing unnecessary loads to the landfill and or transfer stations at this time.

SWSWA facilities will remain open for public use and staff is diligently working to comply with all regulations regarding COVID-19. Your cooperation and adherence to the following guidelines is greatly appreciated. These guidelines will remain in effect until April 10, 2020. At which time they will be revisited and revised as necessary.
